Section 2: Rights of the Person(s) Responsible

- Promptly request the analysis of the B Sample or alternatively waive the analysis of the B Sample.
- Elect to have the B Sample analysed at a different laboratory than the one which performed the A Sample analysis.
- Send a representative (witness) to be present for the B Sample analysis unless the AERA considers such representative or witness presents a threat to the integrity of the analysis process.
- Request copies of the A and B Sample (if applicable) analysis documentation.
